Environmental Protection Agency:

This environmental information site provides regulations and proposed rules, codified regulations, current legislation, and the full text of major environmental laws, such as the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA), the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

This site contains full-text Records of Decision (RODs), ROD Abstracts, ROD Amendments, and Explanations of Significant Differences (ESDs). Users can search by keyword across all ROD documents or by state, site name, and EPA ID for specific ROD documents.

This site provides access to current rulemaking activities, as well as full-text access to selected NUREGs, Inspector General Reports, and Regulatory Guides through the Electronic Reading Room's Document Collections.
